Teaching in this way is something new and different for children, parents & teachers alike and all involved must be congratulated for the way they have thrown themselves into teaching and learning via these platforms and engaging so fully in the learning that was available.

Work on our new outdoor area has started and it is now really starting to take shape. Over the half term break work will begin on the new water tight canopy that will replace the red metal framed structure currently in place. All children will have the opportunity to play on the equipment when the project is complete.

STEAM

This week there has been an excited buzz in the air as children have completed their STEAM projects. In some cases these have been linked to class themes and in others children have been presented with a problem or question they must solve. It is an excellent way for children to make connections between subjects while also practicing critical problem solving and collaborative skills that they can then apply in different contexts. We are delighted that the children have been able to share their learning with you in their zoom presentations at the end of this week.

It has been really interesting to hear of the different causes that are close to our children's hearts and they are happy that they are able to give something from us here at Mill View.
